

## Mariners vs. Angels

Come watch the Seattle Mariners <http://seattle.mariners.mlb.com> take on the Los Angeles Angels <http://losangeles.angels.mlb.com> at Safeco Field on August 28, 2007, at 7:05 p.m. Attending a game at Safeco Field will give you an experience that is unequalled in major league baseball. It offers excellent views of game action from all angles, sweeping views of the downtown Seattle skyline, and breathtaking sunsets over Puget Sound. Safeco Field is also equipped with a one-of-a-kind retractable roof. So, if the forecast for the future is contrary and it starts raining during a game, the giant retractable roof will cover the field and the game can continue--come rain or come shine!

The cost is \$24.00 for both adults and children; children two years old and under get in free. **Transportation is not provided.** Public transportation and taxis are available.

If you decide to walk to the game, it's about a mile and a quarter journey down hill and through the most historic part of the city, Pioneer Square [www.pioneersquare.org](http://www.pioneersquare.org), and Mike Kerr, NCBC Member and Mariners fan, is willing to guide you to Safeco Field and back (uphill!) to the hotel after the game. The cost of a taxi ride to Safeco Field is between \$6 and \$10. A #358 bus runs every 10 minutes and can be boarded at 5<sup>th</sup> and Spring for \$1.50. You would get off the bus at 2<sup>nd</sup> and Washington and walk a couple of blocks west to the stadium. To catch the bus back to the hotel's vicinity, leave the stadium by the main exit which empties out onto 1<sup>st</sup> and Royal Brougham, then walk east to 4<sup>th</sup> and Royal Brougham and board any bus that goes north up to 4<sup>th</sup> and Madison (then walk two blocks east to the hotel). Bus fair is \$1.25 for the return trip to the hotel. **Additional information regarding Seattle and its transportation options will be available at the NCBC Conference concierge desk.**
