Now, therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. That the Order Granting Exemption from Payment of Fees for Electronic Public Access to Court Records entered by this Court on October 2, 2006, granting fee exemption to all Superior Courts, District Courts and Municipal Courts of the state of Washington, as subsequently amended on September 29, 2010 (the "State Exemption Order"), is revoked effective November 15, 2016;
