14 creditors and the Chapter 13 Plan more timely and cost effective if performed by the clerk; it
15 is hereby

16 ORDERED that effective February 1, 2000, the Standing Chapter 13 Trustees for the
17 Western District of Washington may delegate to the clerk the responsibility for sending notice
18 of the section 341 meeting of creditors and the Chapter 13 Plan as set forth in Local
19 Bankruptcy Rules 2002-1(a)(1), 2015-5(a) and 3015-1(c); *provided*, however, that any such
20 delegation will void the Trustee's claim for reimbursement of noticing costs pursuant to Local
21 Bankruptcy Rules 2002-1(g), 2015-5(b), 3015-1(c)(1),(2) and Administrative Order No. 7.
