10 It is hereby ordered that effective November 1, 2003, Local Bankruptcy Rule W.D. of
11 Washington 1072-1(c) is amended to provide that, unless otherwise ordered by the court for a
12 particular motion, motions shall be noted for hearing for chapter 13 cases that are assigned to Judge
13 Thomas T. Glover for Island, San Juan, Skagit, Snohomish, and Whatcom counties in Everett on the
14 2nd Wednesday of each month, or in Seattle on the 4th Thursday of each month. All King county
15 chapter 13 cases assigned to Judge Karen A. Overstreet shall be noted for hearing in Seattle on the 1st
16 and 3rd Wednesday of each month. Chapter 13 cases from Island, San Juan, Skagit, Snohomish, and
17 Whatcom counties that are assigned to Judge Karen A. Overstreet due to conflicts, including without
18 limitation those cases in which Kevin Helenius is record counsel for the debtor, shall be noted for
19 hearing in Seattle on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month. The calendar days may be changed;
20 any changes will be published.

21 It is further ordered that effective November 1, 2003, Local Bankruptcy Rule W.D. of
22 Washington 1072-1(d) is amended to provide that motions in chapter 13 cases assigned to Judge
23 Thomas T. Glover may be noted in Bremerton, and motions in chapter 11 cases assigned to Judge
24 Thomas T. Glover may be noted in Bremerton or Everett.
