**General Order No. 2017-4**

The General Order Authorizing Bankruptcy Judges to Make and Amend Local Rules of Practice and Procedure, issued by the U.S. District Court, Western District of Washington, dated November 21, 2005, and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9029(a), authorize the bankruptcy judges of this District to make and amend rules of practice and procedure. On June 16, 2017, the court published for public comment a proposed amendment to Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9029-2. There were no comments to the proposal.

Now, therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED that** effective September 1, 2017, Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9029-2 is amended to state as follows:

**RULE 9029-2. LOCAL RULES - DISTRICT COURT**

The Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Western District of Washington ("Local Rules W.D. Wash.") are rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Washington, except as (1) they may be inconsistent with Title 11, United States Code ("Bankruptcy Code"), the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, or these Local Bankruptcy Rules, or (2) otherwise ordered by the court.
