Rule 1007-I

Extending the Effective Date for Interim

GENERAL ORDER NO. 2011-5

Interim Rule 1007-I was adopted by General Order 2008-4 and made effective to all cases filed on and after December 19, 2008, through and including December 18, 2011. Interim Rule 1007-I was subsequently amended by General Orders 2010-2 and 2010-3 to address changes in federal time computation rules.

On December 13, 2011, the President signed into law H.R. 2912,the National Guard and Debt Relief Extension Act of 2011, which extended the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008 for an additional four years. Interim Rule 1007-I, promulgated as a result of the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008, must also be extended for an additional four years.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that Interim Rule 1007-I, as previously amended, is extended to be effective, *nunc pro tunc*, for all cases filed on or after December 19, 2011, through and including December 18, 2015.
