General Order No. 2021-03

This General Order clarifies the Court's procedures for hearings and trials in light of improved conditions related to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Washington State. This General Order supersedes the Bankruptcy Court General Orders 2020-3 and 2021-1 as to hearings and is issued in conjunction with the District Court's General Order 10-21 dated June 30, 2021.

Pursuant to Bankruptcy Court General Order 21-01, non-evidentiary hearings are being conducted telephonically through July 31, 2021, and trials and evidentiary hearings may be conducted in person at the discretion of the individual judge. In light of the lifting of COVID-19 restrictions in Washington State and in the courthouses, the Bankruptcy Court further clarifies its procedures as set forth herein.

It is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. Effective August 1, 2021, at the discretion of the assigned judge, non-evidentiary hearings will be conducted in person. Each judge's preference, and the procedures for remote

2 page. Requests for telephonic appearance shall be submitted in accordance with the assigned
3 judge's chambers procedures.

4 2. Each chambers will review evidentiary hearings and trials to determine whether each
5 matter should be continued or conducted in court, telephonically or by video as practicable and
6 will contact the parties accordingly.
