Most Official Bankruptcy Forms will be replaced with substantially revised, renumbered and reformatted forms effective December 1, 2015. These national form revisions necessitate corresponding amendments to the Court's Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

Now, therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The following Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure for the Western District of Washington are revised to reflect the new Official Form name and number:

2. Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 4001-1(b) is revised to remove reference to the filing of “a copy of the judgment of possession or eviction.” Official Forms B101A, Initial Statement About Eviction Judgment Against You, and B101B, Statement About Payment of an Eviction Judgment Against You, are required to seek relief under 11 U.S.C. § 362(l).

3. A declaration under penalty of perjury must accompany all schedules or amended schedules. See Form B106Dec, Declaration About an Individual Debtor’s Schedules, and Form B202, Declaration Under Penalty of Perjury for Non-Individual Debtors. References in the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure to required schedules or amended schedules should be read to include the required applicable form of declaration, particularly in rules 1007-1, 1009-1, and 1017-1.

4. The changes to the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure set forth above are effective December 1, 2015.
