How the Clinic works:

The clinic has experienced bankruptcy lawyers who can:

- look through your forms to catch things that may cause problems for your case
- help you fix problems in your forms and file amended (revised) ones
- step in to represent you in your case, including going with you to the Meeting of Creditors
- advise you in various bankruptcy-related issues

Who qualifies for the Clinic:

# of people in your household:	Total gross income (before taxes & expenses) of everybody in your household:*
1	Less than \$24,280.00 per year
2	Less than \$32,920.00 per year
3	Less than \$41,560.00 per year
4	Less than \$50,200.00 per year
5	Less than \$58,840.00 per year
More than 5	Less than \$8,640.00 more per year for each additional person
