The retirement of Judge Marc L. Barreca, and the subsequent reassignment of cases, necessitates changes to Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1072-1: Places of Holding Court.

Now, therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED**: Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1072-1(c) is amended as follows:

1. Chapter 7 and Chapter 13 Cases with the Debtor's Residence/Principal Place of Business or Assets in Snohomish County, and which are assigned to Judge Dore, shall be noted for hearing in Seattle.

2. This amendment is effective as of April 15, 2024, or upon the reassignment of one of the cases described above from Judge Barreca to Judge Dore.
