On December 19, 2011, the Court entered General Order 2011-6 requiring large volume claim filers to obtain a limited use ECF account for the purpose of electronically filing proofs of claim. As a result of technological advances, the court has now made available a Claims E-Filing program which allows entities to file proofs of claims and claims related pleadings electronically without the need for an ECF account.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED:

- 1. That General Order 2011-6 is RESCINDED; and
- Those individuals and entities who file 10 or more proofs of claim in the
 United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Washington in any 6 month
 period shall file their claims electronically.
 - 3. This General Order is effective as of April 15, 2013.
