**Extending the Effective Date for
Interim Rule 1007-I**

GENERAL ORDER NO. 2016-1

Interim Rule 1007-I, adopted by General Order 2008-4, implements the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008 (the "Act") and provides a temporary exclusion from the bankruptcy means test for reservists and members of the National Guard called up for at least 90 days of active duty or homeland defense activity following September 11, 2001. Interim Rule 1007-I initially applied to all cases filed on or after December 19, 2008, through and including December 18, 2011. Subsequently, Interim Rule 1007-I was extended to cases filed through and including December 18, 2015, corresponding to extensions of the Act. See General Order 2011-5 and 2012-5.

On December 18, 2015, the President signed into law a four-year extension of the Act. See National Guard and Reservist Debt Relief Extension Act of 2015, Pub. L. No. 114-107. Interim Rule 1007-I must also be extended for an additional four years.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that Interim Rule 1007-1, as
2 previously amended, is extended to be effective *nunc pro tunc* for all cases filed on or
3 after December 19, 2015, through and including December 18, 2019.
