**General Order No. 2016-3**

The Judicial Conference of the United States has amended the provisions of the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule for Bankruptcy Courts, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1930. The amendments require, among other things, that orders granting exemptions from the fees for Electronic Public Access (“PACER”) include limitations on the scope and duration of such exemptions.

Now, therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. That the Order Granting Exemption from Payment of Fees for Electronic Public Access to Court Records entered by this Court on October 2, 2006, granting fee exemption to all Superior Courts, District Courts and Municipal Courts of the state of Washington, as subsequently amended on September 29, 2010 (the “State Exemption Order”), is revoked effective November 15, 2016;
